Public Health (Infectious Disease) (Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 read with section 64(c) of the Public Health Act, 2015, the Minister responsible for Health hereby makes the following regulations —

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Infectious Disease) (Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021.

Amendment of S.I. 132 of 2020

2. The Public Health (Infectious Disease) (Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks) Regulations, 2020 is amended by repealing regulation 5 and substituting therefor the following regulation —

Offence and penalties

"5. A person who fails to comply with regulation 2 or regulation 3 commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding SCR20,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 years or to both."
