**PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, 2015**

*(Act 13 of 2015)*

**Public Health (Infectious Disease) (Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks)  
(Amendment) Regulations, 2021**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 read with section 64(c) of the Public Health Act, 2015, the Minister responsible for Health hereby makes the following regulations —

**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Infectious Disease) (Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021.

**Amendment of S.I. 132 of 2020**

2. The Public Health (Infectious Disease) (Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks) Regulations, 2020 is amended by repealing regulation 5 and substituting therefor the following regulation —

**Offence and penalties**

“5. A person who fails to comply with regulation 2 or regulation 3 commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding SCR20,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 years or to both.”
