- Examining Management's reconciliations between source systems and the general ledgers through to the spreadsheet workings.
- Test-checking;
 - source data with those of the related systems,
 - calculations to ensure accuracy of system parameters, and
 - process level maker checker mechanism in the system.

Key audit matters (cont...)

- Management's use of significant judgements relating to the impacts of the evolving COVID-19 pandemic on the Branch.

Management has assessed the impact of the evolving COVID-19 pandemic on its business and financial statements of the Branch as disclosed in Note 30.

We considered such management's assessment in the wake of the evolving COVID-19 pandemic as a key audit matter, since it involved the use of significant management judgments and estimates considering future events, circumstances and impacts on cash flows, based on available information.

We performed the following procedures, among others.

- We gained an understanding of significant judgements used by the management related to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the business of the Branch.
- Obtaining the Branch's profitability and cash flow projections covering a period of not less than 12 months from the reporting period end date and challenging the key assumptions used in preparing the projections and inquiring the management plans and strategies on credit risk, liquidity risk and the exchange rate risk management evaluating the reasonability of the management plans highlighted.
- Evaluating the appropriateness of the assumptions used for the estimates and assessing whether the estimates reflected the latest economic conditions pursuant to the COVID-19 outbreak.
- Inspecting the availability of the credit facility arrangements for the Branch to manage the liquidity on a short term and long-term basis assessing the implication of these on the Branch's liquidity;
- Assessing the adequacy of the financial statements disclosures in relation to the impact of the uncertainty of COVID-19.

Other information

Our opinion on the financial statements does not cover any other information and we will not express any form of assurance conclusion thereon. Management is responsible for the other information. These financial statements do not include any other information.

Responsibilities of Management and those charged with governance for the financial statements

From the matters communicated with those charged with governance, we determine those matters that were of most significance in the audit of the financial statements of the current period and are therefore the key audit matters. We describe these matters in our auditor's report unless law or regulation precludes public disclosure about the matter or when, in extremely rare circumstances, we determine that a matter should not be communicated in our report because the adverse consequences of doing so would reasonably be expected to outweigh the public interest benefits of such communication.





Report on the audit of the Financial Statements

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of Bank AL Habib Limited - Seychelles Branch ("the Branch"), on pages 4 to 44 which comprise the Statement of Financial Position as at December 31, 2020, and the Statement of Profit or Loss and Other Comprehensive Income, Statement of Changes in Equity and Statement of Cash Flows for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion, the Financial Statements on pages 4 to 44 give a true and fair view of the financial position of the Branch as at December 31, 2020, and of its financial performance and its cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), the Seychelles Companies Act, 1972, the Financial Institutions Act, 2004 as amended and the regulations and directives of Central Bank of Seychelles.

Basis of Opinion

We draw attention to Note 26 of the financial statements which describes a material uncertainty regarding the Coronavirus pandemic which is affecting Seychelles severely. Although it is not possible to reliably estimate the length or severity of this outbreak and hence its financial impact, the Branch could be materially and possibly adversely affected by the risks related to the outbreak of COVID-19. COVID-19 forced humanity to go into isolation, supply chain disruptions, lower consumer demand and general market uncertainty. The extent of the impact of COVID-19 on the Branch's operational and financial performance will depend on future market dynamics and developments, including the duration and spread of the outbreak.

However, the Directors at the Branch's Head Office together with local Management are confident that they will continue to have the financial and otherwise support of their Shareholders and are therefore of the opinion that the going concern basis of preparation of these financial statements remains appropriate in the foreseeable future.

Our opinion is not qualified in respect of the above.


