# Constitutional Court (Application, Contravention, Enforcement or Interpretation of the Constitution) (Amendment) Rules, 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 136(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of Seychelles, the Chief Justice makes the following rules —

## Citation

**1.** These rules may be cited as the Constitutional Court (Application, Contravention, Enforcement or Interpretation of the Constitution) (Amendment) Rules, 2021.

### Amendment of Rule 13

**2.** Rule 13 of the Constitutional Court (Application, Contravention, Enforcement or Interpretation of the Constitution) Rules is amended —

- (a) in subrule (1) by repealing the words "10 days" and substituting therefor the words "30 court days";
- (b) by inserting immediately after subrule (2) the following new subrule —

"(3) For the purposes of subrule (1), "court day" means any day other than a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday.
